Planning your timetable

Tests must be taken on the date as shown on this timetable. You can decide when in the day your candidates take the test, you do not need to tell us.

If you need to run more than one sitting of a test on the same day, you must apply using Preparation – Form 8 found at www.cambridgeinternational.org/forms

You must apply for additional sittings 4 weeks before the test. You must keep groups of candidates separate from each other using our Full Centre Supervision regulations until all candidates have taken the test.

If a candidate misses a test, you cannot run the test on a different day.

You are responsible for making sure candidates know:

- The start and finish time for each test
- Any necessary supervision arrangements
